

Bushfire Management Plan for Proposed Quarry on Adams Scrub Road

- Be aware that bushfire prone land is within 100 meters of the site and if ignited operations should cease till total blackout
- No fuels or explosives or mulched material to be stored onsite
- As a quarry is a natural fire suppression area it is the safest refuge in the event of an approaching bushfire. However, all machinery and personnel not involved in bushfire fighting should evacuate by the access road **before** the active fire front is within 500 meters of the site.
- Should evacuation be impossible all machinery should be parked in a square to protect personnel from radiant heat.
- Wait till the fire front passes and smoke clears then evacuate when **all** roads are safe to traverse
- Fire fighting appliances are to be onsite if bushfires are in the area and the earthmoving machinery on site may be used to fight the approaching fire with RFS approval only.
- External firefighting appliances (mainly RFS vehicles) can access the site by the quarry access road
